

In addition, our association was instrumental in supporting some undergraduate students in impoverished situations.

Contributions made to the pursuit of academic excellence at the University of Peradeniya:

AAUPOC has made generous donations of textbooks to the main libraries, computers for resident halls, and scientific instruments to the International Research Center of the University of Peradeniya in the past years.

Special support for students and new alumni:

AAUPOC is involved in supporting Peradeniya graduates who decide to do their postgraduate studies in Ottawa to become well-acquainted and established. In addition, AAUPOC always extends its welcome hand to new alumni friends in Ottawa and helps them settle down and feel at home in their new environment.

Our social events foster interactions and friendships among our alumni and the Sri Lankan community at large and raise funds to support the AAUPOC scholarships.





Congratulations and Best Wishes to AAUPOC for continued success for the next decade!



** Regular scholarships include the number of scholarships committed each year and the additional scholarships/ donations include additional scholarships offered depending on the fund availability and one-time donations to support students with exceptional financial emergencies.

Of the total 51 needy students' studentships offered by the AAUP in 2021 from funding sources around the world, AAUP-(Ottawa Chapter) contributed to 20 studentships (~40% of the total studentships).

Selection Criteria- Needy Students' Scholarship Program of the AAUPOC

AAUPOC's financial assistance to needy students at the University of Peradeniya (UoP) is solely based on the criteria stipulated by the mother alumni of the UoP, Alumni Association of the University of Peradeniya (AAUP). However, the number of scholarship awarded (SLR 36,000 / student/ year) to each faculty per year is determined by the AAUPOC.

Scholarships for needy students are offered to selected undergraduates in need of financial assistance. it is learnt that some undergraduates opt to drop out from studies or are under unbearable stress that affects their studies and mental health due to financial stresses. Such students appeal to respective faculties for financial assistance and other available support, such as counselling services. Annually, the number of students seeking financial assistance from the AAUP tend to increase.



Selection Guidelines

The selection of students for Needy Student's Scholarship Program is the responsibility of the Student Welfare Committee (SWC) of the respective faculties under the supervision and recommendations of the Deans, based on several factors including household income and student's credibility to continue the program. Specifically, the followings factors may be considered in the selection process.

- Financial aid to support differently-able students from financially poor backgrounds needing extra help during their academic program
- Financial support under exceptional emergency or distress situations such as accidents / sexual harassment / physical injury / mental conditions
- Financial support for students who do not receive the stipulated *Mahapola* and other scholarships / funds due to failure at examinations due to medical and family problems
- Financial aid in case of death, permanent total disablement or mental health condition of the father, mother or the bread-winner of the family
- Financial aid under exceptional situations of loss of study material due to natural or other disasters
- For any other such cause as may be deemed appropriate by the Student Welfare Committee, from time to time.


Calling of Applications for Studentships

As we are celebrating our 10th anniversary, it is the time to revive how the events over the last couple of years evolved and give credits to pioneers of the events. The idea of AAUPOC health walk was put forward by Dr. Harini Silva, one of our members, back in 2016. Since then, this activity has become a popular event in the annual event calendar of our organisation. There were two main objectives for the Health Walk: (1) to allow AAUPOC members be aware of and improve their health by participating in a simple activity like walking while chit-chatting with fellow members and friends; and (2) to raise funds for the AAUPOC scholarship program for needy students from registration fees and donations received for the Health Walk.

The Health Walk usually happens on a sunny Saturday morning in the end of summer. Every year, organisers carefully select a beautiful location for the Health Walk, often along a river or a stunning nature trail of about 5-6 km in length in the Ottawa neighbourhood. After a couple of hours, the Health Walk ends with a healthy treat consisting fresh fruits, yogurt, juice and water, offered to all well-deserved walkers who participated in the event.

After the Pandemic...



Unfortunately, the COVID-19 pandemic prevented us getting together in-person for the Health Walk in 2020 and 2021. However, the AAUPOC has been innovative to transform the annual Health Walk into a *Walkathon* with great success. Our members, Manoj De Silva and Tharindu Samarakoon were instrumental in planning and creating a virtual platform that would allow many participants to join the *Walkathon*. In this



virtual platform, participants can register and record their individual daily step counts in their own profile page. In addition, the admins post daily and weekly averages of step counts to motivate only a few slow walkers. Participants have the flexibility to do their walking anywhere they like or using a treadmill. We witnessed that during the *Walkathon* period, the competition among participants to record the highest number of steps becomes intense. (of course, it was an honour system. How about counting more than 30,000 steps in a day and survive to wake up in the next morning??). At the end of the *Walkathon* competition, the winners could grab attractive prizes donated by our sponsors and well-wishers, instead of fresh fruits or yogurts.

MARCHING FORWARD TOGETHER FOR ANOTHER DECADE STARTING IN 20231

Since 2012, I have observed the activities of the AAUPOC which has helped the promotion of science, emerging technologies, the arts and culture. The *Hanthana Pavura* Newsletter, *Hanthana Night*, Walkathons and Webinars have been the premier activities which engaged members and non-members alike.

Given the dire state of Sri Lanka's economy, supporting students in Sri Lanka is urgent and even more crucial than ever before. The AAUPOC fulfilled its primary objectives in the past and could enhance its support by undertaking the following:

- Use of Open Textbooks: An open textbook is a textbook licensed under an open copyright license, and made available
 online to be used freely by students, professors and instructors. The Peradeniya University Library subscribes to
 several electronic databases for the use of staff and students of the University. Access is given either through IP
 address or username/ password.
- 2. **Collaboration**: Consider having a combined Peradeniya Alumni association across North America. This organization could potentially raise larger sums to fund the financial crisis that Peradeniya students are facing.
- 3. **Purchase of Sri Lankan Products:** Products, such as equipment and computer accessories for common usage by students, could be bought online from Sri Lankan vendors to help boost the Sri Lankan economy. The AAUPOC EC could decide whether this is a feasible proposal to implement.

<u>Looking ahead to 2023 and beyond</u>: The AAUPOC activities for members and the Ottawa community could include the following:

- 1. Hanthana Pavura: New features such as a Q & As and a Letters to the Editor Sections could be introduced.
- 2. **Origins of Sinhala Drama:** We could discuss how Sinhala dramas like <u>Maname grew out of the Naadagam tradition</u> to explore our cultural origins and the deep multicultural influences on our treasured traditions.
- 3. **Member Feedback:** We could look at feedback from events to discuss other possible activities. For example, at the AAUPOC event to welcome new members, many showed interest in discussing the lyrics of Sinhala Songs. Should this be explored?

My wishes for 2023 and the decades ahead!

May Sri Lanka arise from the ashes of economic failure to the dawn of a new era of responsible fiscal policy, which could provide the needed resources for an effective service to its people!

May each one of you, the AAUPOC, and our Motherland Sri Lanka experience a wonderful 2023, filled with happiness, success and wellbeing!
