The AAUP parent body is happy to announce that the AAUP Studentship & Scholarship programme has been very successful this year enabling us to offer more than 100 studentships (Rs. 1000 x 12 = 12,000/=). This was made possible thanks to the generous donations received from the AAUP chapters of Victoria in Australia (PUAAViC), New South Wales, Australia, Ottawa in Canada (AAUP-OC) ,Colombo in Sri Lanka (AAUP-CC) and other generous donors who have been supporting the AAUP studentship programme since long.

Studentships & Scholarships Offered by PUAAViC for Year 2013



The [Peradeniya University Alumni Australia, Victoria Chapter in Australia \(PUAAViC\)](#) has donated Rs.540,000/= to offer 45 studentships among all 8 Faculties (Allied Health Sciences 1, Agriculture 5, Arts 6, Dental Sciences 2, Engineering 6, Medicine 10, Science 10, Veterinary Medicine 3, Special Needs 2) for the year 2013 based on financial need.

In addition Rs. 240000/= has been donated (Rs.24000/= x 10) to offer 10 scholarships among students of the Faculties of Arts (2), Engineering (1) and Science (7) based on merit.

These studentships and scholarships will be named "PUAAViC Studentships & Scholarships."

Studentships & Scholarships Offered by PUAAN for Year 2013



The [Peradeniya University Alumni Association New South Wales Chapter in Australia \(PUAAN\)](#) generously donated A\$ 4000.00 to the AAUP Parent Body last year (2012) to offer studentships annually. A Fixed Deposit in the name of "Funds donated by PUAAN for Studentships" for the value of A\$ 4000 (Rs.538,205/=) was made from this money last year. The interest earned from the fixed deposit will be used to offer 5 studentships this year on need base.

The [AAUP Ottawa Chapter in Canada](#) has recently contacted us and donated Rs. 168000/= to offer 14 studentships among students of Faculties of Agriculture, Arts, Dental Sciences, Engineering, Medicine, Science and Veterinary Medicine for the year 2013. Each faculty will receive two studentships under the name “AAUP -Ottawa Canada Chapter studentships”. These studentships will be for ‘needy students’ who achieve a fair level of academic standard.
